NATHAN SPEHR CARVING UP THE COURT FOR NORTH ALABAMA!

Gleeson Old Scholar and University of North Alabama Freshman, Nathan Spehr (2009), has found fine form on the court recently, starring for the Lions throughout the past month.

Nathan signed a four-year contract with the University of North Alabama last year, allowing him to play at an elite level whilst studying a Fitness and Management degree.

The pacy guard hit four three-point baskets and scored a US career-high 22 points, to lead the Lions to an 83-69 away victory against Delta State on Saturday 18th February. He also scored a perfect 4-for-4 from the free throw line on the night.

In early February, Nathan was given an opportunity to take on more court time when the Lions' senior point guard, Keynan Jackson , sprained his ankle. He played an outstanding game and helped the side to a 65-56 victory against West Alabama - the side was trailing by one point with about six minutes remaining before Nathan scored seven of his eight points for the game.

UNA Head Coach Bobby Champagne was impressed with the efforts of his young Aussie recruit:

"We put a lot on Nathan with KJ (Keynan Jackson) out and he responded," Champagne told the Times Daily.

"That's a lot to ask of a freshman, but he hit a couple of big shots and is gaining confidence."

The University of Alabama caters for 7000 students and has a live lion as it's mascot, which lives on campus!

Nathan came to the attention of US scouts whilst playing for the Australian 19-and-under Emus Squad that won the gold medal at the Albert Schweitzer Tournament in Germany in 2011. He also averaged 10 points and 3.2 assists per game for Adelaide hometown club, Sturt, last season.

We congratulate Nathan on his recent performances and wish him all the best for his continued success at UNA - both on and off the court!




